Classroom lecture, simulated labs and supervised clinical experience in long-term care facilities are combined to provide the basic nursing skills and knowledge necessary for students to give patient care appropriately and safely. Upon successful completion (C or better grade) students are eligible for employment in health care facilities and to apply for the State of Michigan Competency test. This course can also be used to articulate into MCC's nursing program.

Classroom lecture and hands-on training in a health care setting are combined to equip students with the skills needed to perform administrative and clinical duties under the supervision of a licensed health care practitioner. Students completing this certicate program are qualicated to work as a medical assistant in a variety of settings including medical oces, outpatient facilities, health maintenance organizations, health departments, business and industry and insurance companies. All courses must be completed within two years to facilitate student success in the externship setting and the national certication exam.
